Managing Detergents and Cleaning Products Formulation Changes

Eco Choice Aotearoa Licence Conditions requires companies to notify Eco Choice Aotearoa of changes to their products.

Cleaning product formulations often require frequent adjustments and updates due to evolving performance requirements, raw material availability, and compliance with environmental or safety standards.

There have been instances of confusion regarding when licence holders should notify Eco Choice Aotearoa of changes to cleaning product formulations. The lack of clarification has led to sometimes unnecessary additional audit costs and administrative burden.

To address this, we have clarified the notification requirements for cleaning product formulation changes. The goal is to ensure that Eco Choice Aotearoa is informed of **significant** changes that could impact compliance, such as: the introduction of new products, new input ingredients, or changes to Globally Harmonised System (GHS)/New Zealand HSNO hazard classifications in existing formulation ingredients used in currently licenced formulations.

This approach aims to both address the need for flexibility required by cleaning product manufacturers while maintaining the integrity of the EC-58 Detergents and Cleaning Products standard and broader ECA certification system.

1. WE REQUIRE NOTIFICATION FOR:

- 1.1. Any new detergent/cleaning products and their formulations to be added to the ECA Licence not previously audited by Eco Choice Aotearoa.
- 1.2. Any new formulation ingredients not previously audited by Eco Choice Aotearoa that are being added to existing licenced formulations.
- 1.3. Any existing formulation ingredients used in a licenced formulation that have changed their hazard rating under the Globally Harmonised System (GHS)/New Zealand HSNO Classes to one that appears in EC-58 Detergents and Cleaning products Appendix C Hazardous Substances Classifications or changes to hazardous properties of the product (see section 6.2)

- 1.4. Any ingredients where its formulation ingredient quantities now exceeds the thresholds outlined in EC-58 Detergents and Cleaning Products (for example: GHS/HSNO hazard statements, VOC levels).

Please refer to sub sections *5.2 Formulations requirements* through to *5.11 Palm oil and palm kernel oil*, and *section 6 Product Characteristics* in the EC 58-19 standard for more information.

2. WE DO NOT REQUIRE NOTIFICATION FOR:

- 2.1. Changes to formulations that contain ingredients already audited by Eco Choice Aotearoa, as long as ingredients have unchanged hazard statements, hazardous properties of the product, and ingredient quantities still meet the threshold requirements specified in EC-58-19.

Documentation of these non-notified formulation changes are expected to be maintained by the licence holder and made available when requested.
